ORDER:

The post of Commercial Tax Officer in the Commercial Taxes Department is a State level post to which the method of recruitment is by 1.Direct recruitment 2. Appointment by transfer from the feeder category of Deputy Commercial Tax Officer and 3. SO/PSs Secretariat quota and the said category was governed by the APCT Service Rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.1781, Rev(CT.I) Department dt.15.10.1963, as per the said rules a 15 point cycle of rotation was followed up to 22.04.1994. Thereafter, new rules were issued vide G.O.Ms.No.360, Rev(CT.I) Department dt.23.04.1994, in which the 10 point cycle was operated as shown below:-

In the reference 1st read above, the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes has published the final integrated seniority list in the cadre of Commercial Tax Officers (CTOs) for the panel year 1975-1976 to 1998-1999 in A.P Gazette No.22-A dt.12.01.2005. The above list was prepared basing on the A.P High Court order dt.09.04.2001 in W.P No.24335/1999 and 14538/2000.

In the reference 2nd read above, certain CTOs, aggrieved by the said seniority list, filed appeal petitions before the Government. With a view to dispose off the petitions Government vide Memo No.16355/CT.I(I)/2005-4 dt.15.06.2006 requested the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes to furnish connected records relating to calculation of vacancies, number of posts meant for direct recruits and promotees/ transferees for the years 1990-91 to 1996-97. The CCT vide his letter No.D2/781/2005 dt.2.4.2007 prepared and furnished fresh seniority list stating that he followed the below mentioned principles in preparation of the list.

1. 15 point cycle of rotation was followed upto 09.06.1994 and ten point cycle was followed thereafter in term of G.O.Ms No.1781 dt.15.10.1963 and G.O.Ms.No.360 dt.23.04.1994 respectively.
2. Rota Quota principle was followed as per the Govt., Memo No.16/Ser.A/93-39, dt.21.04.1999.
3. Communal roster for SC/ST reservation was followed adopting 25 point cycle upto 1985-86 panel year and 100 point cycle thereafter.

4. Inter-se-seniority amongst direct recruit CTOs was followed as per the list furnished by APPSC.
5. City list candidates were placed in the seniority list as per the dates of their joining.

In the reference 5th cited, the appeal of Sri K. Ravi Shankar and other DR CTOs has been rejected. Aggrieved by the rejection orders the DR CTOs approached the Hon'ble APAT through O.A No.702/2006.

In the reference 6th read above, the Hon'ble APAT in its orders dt.29.4.2010 in O.A No.702/2006 and Batch while setting aside the Govt. Orders in Memo No.16355/CT.I(1)/2005, dt.5.7.2008, directed the Government to approve the revised seniority list submitted by the Commissioner Commercial Taxes in his reference No D2/781/05, dated.02.04.2007 and consequently review all the promotions in the light of the revised seniority list dt.2.4.2007. In the afore mentioned order of APAT, the Hon'ble Tribunal, while extensively quoting the pronouncements made by the Apex Court, stressed that the respondents must follow Rota Quota rule as prescribed in the special rules governing the CTO post. The Hon'ble Tribunal also observed that the "deduction method" adopted by the respondents in calculating the substantive vacancies and determining the seniority of the applicants, viz., respondents, has no sanction of any settled proposition of law, rules or regulations. Accordingly the Hon'ble APAT has directed that the determination of seniority of the applicants in the O.A and that of all the respondents shall be governed by Rule 33 of AP State and Subordinate Service Rule.

While observing as above, the Hon'ble APAT has directed the Government to approve the revised seniority list submitted by the second respondent in CCT's reference No.D2/787/2005 dt.2.7.2007 and to subsequently review all the promotions in the light of the revised seniority list dt.2.4.2007.

Pursuant to the aforementioned direction of Hon'ble APAT, Government have scrutinized the seniority list dt.2.4.2007 furnished by the CCT. On such scrutiny the Government have found that there are certain errors apparent on the face of the record in applying the Rota Quota rule and in allocating the vacancies in certain panel years among the three categories. i.e. 1.DRs, 2.RPs and 3.City List candidates. The same were rectified, as given below;

- i) Although 54 vacancies were allocated against the City list quota as per the Rota Quota rule, as many as 59 candidates belonging to City List quota were accommodated in the said seniority list

which exceeds the available vacancies by 5. Hence 5 names were deleted.

- ii) Sri B. Laxmana Swamy was included in the panel year 1994-95 although he expired in the year 1990-1991 while working as DCTO. Hence his name has been deleted.
- iii) In the panel year 1997-98 the name of Sri T. Rajesham (ST) was substituted by that of Sri D. Yadagiri (ST), who was previously assigned seniority above Sri T. Rajesham vide Govt. Memo. No.30657/CT.I/2008 dt.24.11.2008.
- iv) According to the 25 cycle of reservation, which was in vogue up to the panel year 1985-1986, reservation for the SC category was provided, inter-alia, at the 12th roster point in the third and fourth cycle. However in the list submitted by CCT on 2.4.2007 the said 12th point in the third and fourth cycle was filled up by open competition candidates and was thus clearly against the rule of reservation. As such the same has been rectified.
- v) Based on the above a provisional seniority list of 575 names in the panel year 1975-1976 to 1998-1999 was published in the Gazette No.137, Dated.31.08.2010 inviting objections or representations, if any, from the persons affected by the said provisional seniority list.

In the reference 9th and 10th read above, while enclosing the revised provisional seniority list of CTOs. The Commissioner of Commercial Taxes has been requested to follow the due procedure laid down in rule 24 of APS &SS Rules,1996, and issue show cause notices to all the persons likely to be affected by calling for objections, if any, from them. And if any objections is received examine the same and send his report along with the remarks to the Government to finalize the seniority list. Accordingly in the reference 11th read above, the said list was published in A.P.Extraordinary Gazette No.137, dated.31.08.2010.

In the reference 12th read above, the CCT has communicated the objections received from the affected persons, submitted his detailed remarks to the Government for further action.

The objections raised relating to the basic principles governing the revision of panel seniority are detailed below

Objections on general Principle:-

- a). Certain basic objections have been received from some of the employees stating that the list furnished by the CCT on 2.4.2007 should have been approved as such without any further process at the Government level. The Government is of the view that it is inconceivable to construe that the Hon'ble APAT in O.A No.702/2006 would have issued a direction which mandated the Government to revise the seniority list published in Gazette No.22-A dt.12.1.2005 without giving opportunity of representation to the persons concerned which is a basic tenet of the principle of natural justice. It could not also be conceived that the errors apparent on the face of the record, as have been mentioned in the preceding para should have been ignored while finalizing the seniority list in the cadre of CTO. As such after observing the basic requirements of the principle of natural justice the seniority list has been sought to be confirmed. The objections raised in this regard are therefore untenable.
- b) Another basic objection that has been raised by some of the employees is against alteration of the settled seniority after a long lapse of time, especially when several promotions have been affected basing on the old seniority list. It is felt that this objection has been adequately answered in the direction of the APAT itself in para 23 of its order dated.29.04.2010 in O.A No. 702/2006.
- c) Another preliminary objection has been raised stating that several litigations are pending in the Hon'ble APAT and in the AP High Court challenging the seniority list in the lower categories of ACTO's and DCTOs. The request is to take up finalization of CTO seniority only after settlement of all the disputes in the cadres of ACTO/DCTO. In this connection it is found that the exercise for revision of the CTO cadre seniority has been taken up in obedience of the specific direction the Hon'ble Tribunal in O.A No.702/2006. The said list, even after being finally published would obviously be subject to final decision of the APAT / High Court issued in any litigation pending before the said Tribunal / High Court.
- d) Names of employees who actually worked as CTOs and have drawn salaries in that cadre have been included in the list as per their relative seniority in the DCTO cadre (lower cadre) even though they might have retired before or in the panel year in which they were included. This has

been done so that more than the permitted slots, as per rota-quota rule, are not occupied by the promotee/CL candidates.

- e) Relative seniority among various categories i.e. DRs/RPs/CL quota candidates has been fixed on the basis of rule 33(a) of General Rules.
- f) The Rule of reservation in respect of SCs/STs has been followed even prior to 2003 in view of Rule 4 of APCT service Rules read with rule 22 of APS & SS Rules.
- g) The substantive vacancies earlier taken in to account from the panel year 1975-76 to 1998-99, as published in the show cause notice; have been revised based on the CCTs report duly following rota-quota principle and rectifying other discrepancies.

The principles adopted at (a-g) above meets the objections raised by the following individuals, namely, 1. N.V.Narasimha Rao, I/c. D.C.(CT), 2. P.Narasimha Rao, I/c.D.C.(CT), 3. Sri. Ch.Srinivas, I/c.D.C.(CT), 4. D. Bhasakar Reddy I/c. D.C (CT), 5.B.Surya Prakash Rao, I/c. D.C.(CT), 6. K. Anantham, I/c. DC (CT), 7. K.Narayana Prasad, I/c DC(CT), 8. P.Neelakanta Rao, I/c DC(CT), Guntur.II, 9. K.V.Ramanaiah, AC(CT)

(i) Rule 6(b) of old APS & SS Rules and Rule 4(b) of new APS & SS Rules, 1996 read with explanation, with reference to treatment of temporary vacancies was not reflected and intimated. It is evident that DR CTOs were shown against the slot for temporary vacancies which is an violation of the APS & SS Rules. They have requested to cause necessary rectification in this regard.

(ii) The name of Sri. T. Pardhasarathi was shown at SI.No.251 in the panel year 1989-90. He was in fact removed from service vide G.O.Ms.No. 1469 Revenue (SS) Department dt: 14.11.1986. As such his name was not included in the seniority list published in A.P., Gazette No. 22-A, dt: 12.01.2005. The candidates mentioned at SI.No. 238, 254,255,288, 289, 294, 332, 337, 368, 377, 381,399, 412, 451, and 476 have been proposed to be included in the seniority list as addition to the seniority list published in Gazette No. 22-A without verifying eligibility. Hence, they have requested to verify the eligibility of the candidates against the SI.Nos mentioned above.

(iii) For the candidates mentioned at SI.No.81, 97, 123, 157, 391 and 420 the date of birth and date of retirement have been shown blank and requested to rectify the omissions.

Reply;

(i) No post in C.T. Dept, after creation, has ever been disbanded in the past. Hence all vacancies have been taken as substantive at this distance of time. Therefore the apportionment of the DR vacancies is against substantive vacancies only. Therefore this objection is overruled.

(ii) The name of Sri T.Pardhasarathi, whose name was shown at Sl.No.251 in the panel year 1989-90, was in fact removed from service vide G.O.Ms.No.1469, Rev(SS) Dept, dated.14.11.1996. Accordingly his name was removed from the seniority list.

(iii) The details relating to candidates mentioned at Sl.No.81, 97, 123, 157, 391 and 420 have since been incorporated.

Objection filed by Sri G. Krishna Rao, Commercial Tax Officer

He was recruited by transfer from Secretariat quota in the year 1994-95 against one vacancy out of 3 carry forward S.T. vacancies relating to the year 1990-91. He has submitted that his name should be considered against the ST vacancy which arose in the year 1990-91 and seniority fixed in 1990-91 panel year only.

Reply:

It is observed that Sri G. Krishna Rao was working originally as Superintendent in Co-operative Dept., and was appointed as Section Officer, A.P.Secretariat during the year 1994-95 and joined as such on 25.06.1994. Hence his seniority in the cadre of Section Officer was counted with effect from 25.06.1994 only. He was appointed by transfer as CTO, against a S.T vacancy in the City List Quota on 01.11.1995 (i.e. 1994-95 panel year). Hence his request to give him seniority from a date when he had not even joined the department. i.e., 1990-91 cannot be accepted. At that time he was not even eligible to be posted as CTO in the CT Dept. Merely a backlog vacancy existed since that year. Hence, his claim is devoid of merits and rejected.

Objection filed by Sri. M.A.Samad, DCTO(Retd.)

The individuals stated that his name has been included in the panel of CTOs for the year 1991-92 and his date of birth is shown in 01-12-1936 against his name, but his actual date of birth is 02-03-1938 and requested to rectify the same.

Reply:

The date of birth and date of retirement of Sri M.A.Samad, at Sl. No.295 of seniority list in the panel year 1992-93 have since rectified as requested.

Objection filed by Sri. T.Ramesh Babu, Joint Commissioner (CT)

The officer has stated that he is a 1987 batch DR CTO and his name has been incorrectly mentioned at Sl.No. 213 in the seniority list of CTOs below the name of Sri. T.S.Vijaya Kumar (S.No.211) and Sri V.Harshavardhan (S.No.212) and that his name should be above Sri. V.Harshavardhan. In his support he has cited G.O.Ms.No.908, 909 & 910, Rev (CT-I) Dept. dt. 15-07-2000 in which Sri. T.Vijayakumar, Sri.T.Ramesh Babu and V.Harshavardhan were promoted in that order.

Reply;

Sri T. Ramesh Babu, was selected by the A.P.P.S.C. as DR Commercial Tax Officer and appointed by the Government vide G.O.Ms. No. 548 Revenue (S) dept, dt. 5.6.1987. As per the roster based selection list furnished by the APPSC the name of the individual was shown as given below:-

Since the 3 O.C candidates at Sl.No.15, 17 and 19 above had secured same marks (i.e.854) Sri T.S.Vijaya Kumar Sl.No.19 requested for a higher position in the inter-se-seniority list, vis-à-vis Sri V.Harshavardhan and Sri C.Ramakrishna in the order of their relative age. Accordingly Govt. have decided vide G.O.Rt.No.573, dated. 12.04.1999 to accept his claim. Basing on that if the O.C candidate appearing at Sl.No.15,17 and 19 were rearranged in the descending order of their age the seniority would be recast as follows:-

Keeping this in mind the objection is accepted and the necessary correction to the provisional list has been made.

Objections filed by Sri. T.Rajesham, I/C, AC(CT)

The individual has submitted that he has been included in the panel of CTO's for the year 1996-97 against S.T. backlog vacancy vide G.O.Rt.No.846 Rev(CT-I) Dept. dt. 03-06-1998 and joined as CTO on 09-06-1998. His name was shown at Sl.No.629 against ST vacancy in the seniority list of CTOs published in AP Gazette No. 22-A. In the proposed seniority list his name is not

included and the reasons are not known to him after a lapse of 5 years. Further the officer has stated that certain CTO's, who are included against ST category in the revision of seniority list, are facing charges due to submission of bogus ST Certificate [Sri. A.Pentala Rao Sl.No.8 (ST bogus certificate), Sri L.P.Prasad Sl.No.140 (ST bogus certificate, case is under process for cancellation of ST Certificate), Smt. K.Santhamma, Sl.No.448 dismissed from Govt. service vide G.O.Rt.No.225, Rev (Vig.I) Dept., dt.02-02-2007]. In view of the placing of above bogus ST candidates against the Roster points meant for ST candidates, a real ST like him is missing placement from the seniority list of CTO's. The officer has requested to delete the above bogus ST candidates from the seniority list.

He has stated that the Govt. have issued G.O.Ms.No.1086 Rev(CT.I) Dept., dt.09-08-2007 restoring the SC/ST points in the seniority list of CTO's as 19 and 7, and requested the Commissioner(CT) to take further action vide Government Memo No. 59970/CT.I(1)/2005 dt.22-07-2009.

He has requested to place his name in the seniority list of Commercial Tax Officers in the appropriate panel year, as was done while finalizing the seniority lists of CTOs and published in the year 2005 and place his name against the ST vacancy.

Reply:

The present proposed seniority list for the cadre of CTO has been prepared basing on the number of vacancies available in different panel years and the relative seniority in the DCTO cadre. The seniority positions in the CTO cadre have been assigned duly taking into account the communal roster. As per this Sri B.Shankar, who is senior to Sri T.Rajesham, occupied the last ST slot available i.e., in the panel year 1997-98. Hence Sri T.Rajesham could not be given placement in the panels finalized up to 1998-99. His name would find place at appropriate position in a subsequent panel year. Further G.O.Ms.No.1086, dated. 09.08.2007, referred to in the objection petition, has since been set aside by the Hon'ble APAT in OA No.10358/2009, dated.21.06.2010.

With regard to the objection raised relating to S.T status of Sri A.Pentala Rao (1975-76 panel) and Sri L.P.Prasad, (1988-89 panel) it is observed that they retired on 31.10.1986 and 30.04.2000 respectively. Smt K.Shatamma was dismissed from service on 02.02.2007. All of them occupied the position of CTO and as such have to be shown in the seniority list, as for none of them S.T. status has so far been cancelled. Hence the objection is over ruled.

The officers have submitted that their names have not been included in the seniority list/show cause notice.

Reply:

The seniority list in the cadre of CTOs, finalized and published in A.P. Gazette No. 22-A, dt.12.01.2005, has been revised basing on the orders of the Hon'ble APAT in O.A. No. 702/06, dt.29.4.2010. The apportionment of the vacancies of CTOs was made duly following the rota-quota rule, as provided in the Special Rules. As a result of this exercise, some of the rank promotees had to be relegated to lower positions as compared to their position in Gazette No.22-A. The names of the above individuals had also to be relegated to lower positions since adequate vacancies were not available up to the panel year 1998-99 to accommodate their names in the order of their DCTO seniority.

Objections filed by Sri. M.Subrahmanyam, CTO.

He is submitted that due to non-finalization of seniority list on the basis of quota-rota system in the cadre of ACTO so many rank promotees who were promoted temporarily as ACTOs against DR quota vacancies became seniors. Some candidates, who have not worked as CTOs were included in the CTOs seniority list, e.g. Sri. M.Venkata Swamy, Sl.No.404. Further he has submitted that some vacancies meant for SCs were kept vacant during the panel year 1997-98 at Sl.No.557, 569 and 574 during the panel year 1998-99. As per Rule 33-A of APS & SS Rules, his name should be included in the panel year 1997-98.

Reply:

For the objection that the rota-quota system shall be followed in the cadre of ACTO also, it is informed that the ACTO seniority list has become final was settled long ago. It has also been reported by the CCT that Sri M.Venkata Swamy (1995-96 panel) did work as regular CTO. Further due to revised calculation of substantive vacancies actually available for filling up during the panel years 1975-76 to 1998-99, as reported by the CCT, only 553 positions could be filled up by applying the rota-quota rule. As such Sl.No.557, 569 and 574 did not arise in the final seniority list. The objection is therefore overruled.

Objection filed by Sri. K. Srinivasa Rao, I/c DC(CT), Kadapa Division.

The officer has submitted that his name has been included in the panel of CTOs for the year 1993-94 and his date of birth is shown as 01-07-1953 against his name, but his actual and correct date of birth is 26-01-1960 and requested to rectify the same.

Reply:

The date of birth and date of retirement of Sri K.Srinivasa Rao(RP)(ST) have since been rectified as requested basing on the report of the CCT.

The officers have filed their objections to the show cause notice as mentioned below:

- 1) While accepting the allotment of roster points to SC and ST candidates against the vacancies earmarked for rank promotees in the cadre of CTOs for the panel year 1975-76 to 1998-99, it is stated that as per the finalized list of CTOs from 01-11-56 to 11-07-68 and from 12-07-68 to 17-10-75 vide G.O.Ms.No.547 Rev. (CT-I) Department, dated: 30-07-88, it has been un-earthed that Sl.No.144 is shown as vacant with a remark i.e., “to go to SC(RP)” and further two vacancies at Sl.No.146 & 147 shown as vacant with a remark i.e., “to go to DCTOs”. All these 3 vacancies have to be carried forward to next panel i.e., 1975-76 but the same has not taken place. If this omission is made good they will be eligible to claim seniority against the earlier SC roster point.
- 2) They further submitted that Smt. P.S.L. Shanthakumari(SC) at Sl.No.324 in the provisional integrated seniority list in the cadre of CTOs from 1975-76 to 1998-99 was appointed as Jr.Asst. in the year 1976 in Zone-II. She was given notional promotion in the cadre of ACTO in Zone-II in the panel year 1979-80 and also notional promotion in the cadre of DCTO in Zone-II in the panel year 1986-87. Thereafter she was promoted as CTO in the year 1998 by which time she was regularly officiating as CTO. Even without effecting notional promotion in the cadre of CTO she was given notional seniority in the provisional integrated seniority list in the cadre of CTO and placed at Sl.No.324 against the SC roster point 7 available in the panel year 1992-93 in contravention of rule 24 of AP State and Sub-ordinate Service Rules 1996. Therefore she needs to be relegated from the panel year 1992-93 to the panel year 1998-99 since she was regularly officiating as CTO during the year 1998-99 consequent on which she will be eligible to claim seniority in the cadre of CTO against the earlier SC roster points.
- 3) They also submitted that Sri. M.Venkataswamy (SC) at Sl.No.404 in the provisional integrated seniority list in the cadre of CTOs from 1975-76 to 1998-99 was appointed as Jr.Asst. in the year 1967 in Zone-III. He was given notional promotion in the cadre of ACTO in Zone-II for the panel year 1978-79 vide G.O.Rt.No.302, Rev.CT-I Dept, dt.27-2-1997.

Subsequently he officiated as in-Charge CTO in the cadre of DCTO during the period from 2001 till his retirement dt. 31-12-2003. But he was never promoted to the cadre of CTO nor given any notional promotions in the cadre of CTO inspite of the fact he was given notional seniority in the provisional integrated seniority list and placed at Sl.No.404 against the SC roster point 72 SC available in the panel year 1994-95 in contravention of rule 24 AP State and Sub-ordinate Service Rules 1996. Therefore he needs to be relegated to the panel of 1998-99 consequent on which he will be eligible to claim seniority in the cadre of CTO against earlier SC roster points.

- 4) They further submitted that the individuals who have been included in the panels promoted and officiated as CTOs were denied seniority in the provisional integrated seniority list in the cadre of CTO from 1975-76 to 1998-99 even though they were eligible along with their immediate juniors in the lower cadre of DCTOs who have been assigned seniority in the provisional integrated seniority list of CTOs as detailed therein:

Therefore it is just and obligatory that the above individuals need to be assigned seniority along with their immediate juniors in the interest of natural justice and rules in force in the event of which majority of them would retire from service during the currency of the panel.

In addition to the first and fourth objections, Sri D. Yadagiri, CTO filed further objections as under:

5 (a) That Sri B.S.V. Prasad Rao, ST at Sl.No.75 in the Show Cause notice was actually retired from service as ACTO and never promoted as DCTO and included in the DCTO seniority list, but assigned seniority in the CTO list, therefore he requested to delete the said name.

(b) He requested to restore the 10 vacancies of SCs and 3 vacancies of ST which were actually allotted to the OC category in the seniority list for the period from 1.11.56 to 17.10.75 which was issued in G.O.Ms.No. 547 dt.30.07.88 and which were restored in G.O.Ms.No.1086, dt.9.8.07.

(c) He further, objected for his inclusion in the panel year 1998-99 in the SC notice. He stated that he was actually included in the panel year 1997-98 by the review DPC held on 29.7.2010 and included in the seniority list of CTOs. But in the proposed revised seniority list he was included in the panel year 1998-99.

(d) He further stated that Smt Chageshwari belonging to ST category is junior to him in all cadres, but her name was proposed above his name, therefore he requested to place his name above her name in the revised seniority list.

Reply:

Point No.1 As verified from the G.O.Ms.No.547 Dated.30.07.88, the vacancies at Sl.No.144, 146 and 147 were earmarked as follows:-

Thus all the three vacancies were meant for OC candidates only and not for SCs/STs.

Point No. 2 & 3 the present proposed seniority list for the cadre of CTO is prepared on the basis of the directions of the Hon'ble A.P.A.T. in O.A. No. 702/06, dt.29.04.2010. With regard to fixation of seniority in respect of rank promotes the placement is based on availability of appropriate roster point and the feeder category i.e. DCTOs seniority among the corresponding roster category employees. Smt P.S.L.Shanta Kumari, an SC category employee, was placed against roster point 16 in the panel year 1992-93 basing on her inter-se-seniority among eligible SC employees in DCTO cadre. Hence the objection regarding her is overruled. Similarly Sri M.Venkata Swamy was given placement against vacancy at R.P.No.77 arising in the panel year 1995-96 based on his DCTO cadres seniority among SC employees.

Point No.4. Out of the 8 DCTO names pointed out for inclusion in seniority list of CTO on par with their juniors, it is found on verification that the name of Sri R.P.P.S. John Bob was not included in the provisional list by oversight and the same has since been included at Sl.No.321 in the panel year 1992-93 on par with his juniors. Further Sri B. Subbaraya Chetty has already

been included at Sl.No. 346 of the provisional seniority list (364 of final list in the panel year 1993-94. With regard to the other (6) DCTOs, they never worked as CTOs and retired from service as DCTOs only by the time of arising of vacancy. Hence the objection is overruled.

Point 5(a)(b)(c) and (d) With regard to the specific objections of Sri D. Yadagiri it is found that :

- a) Sri B.S.V. Prasad Rao(ST) was included in the seniority list of DCTOs at Sl.No. 79. Accordingly his name was included in the SCN against available ST roster point.
- b) The G.O. stated by the officer was already set aside by the Hon'ble A.P.A.T. in O.A. No.10358/ 2009, dt.21.06.2010. Therefore the objection is overruled.
- c) & d) As per the revised seniority both the names could not find place for want of vacancy. Hence the objection is overruled. In fact the name of Sri D.Yadagiri himself could not be included in the final seniority list for want of vacancy.

Objection filed by Sri. B. Surya Rao, C.T.O.

The officer has submitted that the Government have allowed his appeal vide Memo.No.29243 / CT-I/2/2008, dated: 18.05.09 that Sri. D. Yadagiri, C.T.O an S.T Candidate is junior to him in the cadre of ACTO & DCTO as well as in CTO also. In A.P Gazette No. 13, dated: 01.04.2010 CCT issued notices to 23 affected ACTOs but Sri. D. Yadagiri, who is the CTO at present, has been shown at Sl.No. 565 of 1998 -99 Panel Year of CTOs but his name is not at all figuring though he is senior to him in all cadres. The retired officer has stated that the said individual has been shown as junior in the various Gazette notifications namely A.P Gazette E.O.No.19/10-1-2004, and in part I No. 52/28-12-2000, and also E.O. No.431/7-9-02 and in the part I E.O. No.328/15-7-02. He has requested to examine all the factors submitted and other rules governing the application of rule of reservation for SC & ST candidate and also include his name at Sl.No.557 which is earmarked vacancy for SC candidates left blank in the Show cause Notice in the panel year 1997-98 above Sri. D. Yadagiri, CTO who is in the panel 1998-99.

Reply:

For want of vacancies neither the name of Sri D.Yadagiri nor of Sri B.Surya Rao could not be included in the panel seniority list from 1975-76 to 1998-99. Hence the objection raised is infectious.

Objections filed by;

S/Sri/Smt;

1. J. Tata Rao, AC (CT), 2. T. Siva Sankar Rao, AC (CT), 3.D. Ramesh, AC (CT), 4.J.V.M. Sarma, AC (CT) and 4. K. Haritha, AC (CT).

i) The officers have filed objections stating that the names of certain officers were deleted in the Show Cause Notice without assigning any reason which facilitates induction of the candidates from far behind figured out in Gazette No. 22-A are given below for correction.

1. Sri. K.C.H. Koteswara Rao (Sl.No. 438, 1993-94 Panel, in 22-A)
2. Sri. J.L.N. Sastry (Sl.No.441, 1993-94 Panel, in 22-A).
3. Sri. B.Md. Haneef (Sl.No.448, 1993-94 Panel, in 22-A).
4. Sri. Mohd. Hussain (Sl. No.463, 1993-94 Panel ,in 22-A).

They requested to include the above names in the present seniority list since otherwise it will create disadvantage to them as it would catapult some candidates.

ii) The minimum eligibility criteria in feeder category to qualify for promotion has not been followed. The names of Sri. N. Venkata Narasimhulu , DCTO 1983-84 shown in 1984-85 of CTOs Panel and Sri. M.M. Paramashivam, DCTO 1982-83 shown in 1984-85 of CTOs panel.

iii) The names of Sri R.L.Purushottam (SC) 1982-83 panel of CTOs Sl.No.97 in Gazette 22-A and Sri. R. Sanjeeva Rao (SC) also not figure but Sri R.L.Purushottam is eligible for 1991-92 Panel since his Date of Birth is 09.11.1937. By virtue of the above anomalies some of the SC candidates were pushed up above them causing damage to their seniority.

iv) Sri J. Tata Rao, AC (CT), and Sri. T. Siva Sankar Rao, AC (CT) have filed further objections stating that the Government, vide G.O.Rt.No.1327 dated: 16.09.2010, included the name of Sri. N. Immanuel, ACTO (Retired) in the panel of DCTO for the year 1980-81 in Zone-III assigning notional seniority in the year 1980-81 of Zone assigning notional date w.e.f.28.04.1991. The individual belongs to SC community and he is entitled to be included in the CTOs panel in the year 1982-83 by virtue of the G.O. Hence, the name of the above said individual may replace the person who was already in the panel year by relegating him to the subsequent panel year.

Reply:

Point No. i) The objection with regard to non inclusion of certain DCTOs in the list, though their names figured in the seniority list finalized in A.P. Gazette No. 22-A, dt. 12-1-2005, has been examined.

The seniority list in the cadre of CTOs finalized and published in A.P. Gazette No. 22-A, dt.12.01.2005, is under revision basing on the orders of the Hon'ble APAT in O.A. No. 702/06, dt.29.4.2010. The apportionment of the vacancies of CTOs among feeder categories was made duly following the rota-quota rule as provided in the Special Rules. As a result of this exercise some of the rank promotees had to be relegated to lower positions. Some of them had retired from the service in the cadre of DCTO by the date when CTO vacancy is

arose. The names of 4 persons cited in the objections are in this category, as given below.

Therefore, the objection is over ruled.

Point No.ii) Sri. N. Venkata Narasimhulu, and Sri. M.M. Paramashivam, belong to 1982-83 panel of DCTOs. As per the integrated seniority list of DCTOs and as per their eligibility they were already placed in the 1984-85 panel of CTOs at Sl.No.144 & 145 in the revised show cause notice. Therefore, their objection is not correct.

Point No.iii) With regard Sri R.L.Purushottam(SC)(RP) his name has been included in the panel year 1980-81. With regard to Sri R.Sanjeev Rao (SC)(RP), he retired as DCTO by the time vacancy arose in the cadre of CTO. Hence he was not included in the seniority list. Hence the objection is overruled.

Point No.iv) With regard to Sri N. Immanuel(RP), it was found on verification of records that he belongs to BC (C) community. The DCTOs of the panel year 1980-81 find their place in the CTO seniority list in the panel year 1991-92, but Sri M.Immanuel retired in the year 1985. Hence their objection is overruled.

For the objection that the Government have disturbed the seniority list submitted by the CCT in the reference No.D2/781/2005, dt: 2.04.2007 which amounts to the violation of the directions given by the Hon'ble A.P.A.T in O.A. No.702/2006 and O.A. No.6358/2008 it is to be noted that the errors apparent in the list submitted by the CCT were rectified at Govt. level and after publishing the provisional seniority list on the basis of such rectification only the final seniority list is sought to be published. Hence there is no violation of Hon'ble APAT orders.

Objection filed by Sri N. Pandu Ranga Rao, AC (CT).

The officer has submitted that his name has not found place in the cadre of CTO in the Show Cause Notice even though he worked as CTO vide CCTs orders D2/446/94, dated: 22.05.1996 and joined as CTO (OFA), Punjagutta on 24.05.1996 and he has worked as regular CTO Ladbazar. The officer has requested to include his name at appropriate place i.e., at Sl.No.511 below

Sri. V. Jagadeeswara Rao and above Sri A. Dayaldas either in the panel year 1995-96 or 1996-97.

Reply;

The name of the Sri N.Pandu Ranga Rao could not find place in the seniority list prepared up to the panel year 1998-99 basing on his DCTO cadre seniority and availability of vacancies. In fact Sri V.Jagadeswara Rao(RP) himself could not be included in the panels for the same reason. However Sri A.Dayaldas belongs to City List category and has been included against a slot meant for City List Quota.

Objection filed by Sri. J. Kondaiah, I/c. CTO (Retd)

The individual has submitted that he retired from service on 30.06.1997 in the cadre of DCTO holding Incharge of the post of CTO. His name was placed SI.No.356 in the panel year 1992-93 of CTOs publish in A.P., Gazette No. 22-A, dated: 12.01.2005.

The retired officer has stated that he reported for duty as I/c. CTO on 04.01.1994, the terminal benefits were sanctioned in the cadre of DCTO. His name was placed in the SI.No.298 in the panel of CTOs for the year 1991-92 in the present show cause notice. The officer has requested to assign notional seniority in the cadre of CTO.

Reply;

The individual has been assigned notional seniority in the panel year 1992-93.

Objections filed by Sri Sarfaraj Ali Khan (CTO)(Retired)

The retired officer has stated that he was promoted as CTO w.e.f.27.08.1993 and requested to assign the notional date of seniority from that date and sanction the pensionary benefits from that date.

Reply;

The officer was earlier included in the CTO seniority list, finalized and published in the A.P. Gazette 22-A, dt.12-1-2005, in the panel year 1993-94. Due to revision of this seniority in terms of the orders of the Hon'ble A.P.A.T. basing on his DCTO seniority and rota-quota rule his name has been relegated to the panel year 1995-96. Therefore, the request for assigning the notional date from 27.08.1993 can not considered.

Objection filed by Sri P.Jakaraiah, Joint Commissioner (CT)

The officer has submitted his objections to the Revision of Seniority list stating that he had joined as direct recruit ACTO through by APPSC in the year 1978 and was promoted as DCTO on 20-03-1987, promoted as CTO in the year

1990 vide G.O.Ms.No.255, dated 28-02-1990. In the said order his name was shown at S.No.1 against S.C.Vacancy while showing the name of Sri Y.Kullaiswamy at S.No.2 against the S.C. vacancy. The said order has become final and enforceable as the same was not challenged in any Court of law and continued to be in force. Subsequently he was promoted as Asst. Commissioner (CT) on 26-09-2000 and further promoted as Deputy Commissioner(CT) on 25-02-2008 with a notional date 30-11-2006 and later on promoted as Joint Commissioner(CT) with a notional date 25-02-2008. After long time of more than 20 years, his seniority is being shown at Sl.No.333 in the panel of 1992-93 while showing the name of Sri Y.Kullaiswamy at Sl.No.193 in the panel year 1986-87. It is impossible to imagine as to how his name can be shown at S.No.333 instead of showing 193 if not above.

Reply:

It is informed that the present proposed seniority list for the cadre of CTO is prepared on the basis of the directions of the Hon'ble A.P.A.T. in O.A. No. 702/06, dt.29.04.2010. With regard to fixation of seniority in respect of rank promotees, the placement is based on the feeder category i.e. DCTO seniority. The DCTO seniority has been finalized after taking into the consideration all the objections. As per the finalized integrated seniority list of DCTOs the name of Sri Y. Kullaiah Swamy (SC) figures at Sl. No. 402 and the name of Sri P. Jakaraiah figures at Sl.No. 523. Accordingly their names were included in the seniority list of CTOs at appropriate places. Hence his objection is overruled.

Objections filed by:

1. S. Sekhar, 2. V. Raghunadh, 3. I. Srinagesh, 4. S.V.K. Visweswar Rao, 5. G. Dwarakanadh Reddy, 6. Y. Kiran Kumar, 7. N. Sai Kishore, 8. K. Nagendra. 9. G. Phanindra Reddy, 10. K. Seethalakshmi, 11. T. Rajasekhar, 12. N. Srinivas Rao, 13. R. Balaji Babu, 14. G. Kalpana, 15. K. Geetha, 16. G.Lavanya, and 17. I. Samyuktha Rani.

(I) The error in the calculation of vacancies in different panel years may be rectified. The total number of vacancies arrived at by the department between the panel year 1990-91 and 1996-97 was 346, whereas the total number of vacancies arrived at by them for the same period is 296 only. Thus there is difference of 50 vacancies which has to be reconciled.

They have listed out the differences in number of vacancies in the list appended to the objections the gist of which is as under:

- a) There are 32 vacancies available for the panel year 1990-91 as against 48 vacancies adopted in the show Cause Notice.
- b) There are 51 vacancies available for the panel year 1992-93 as against 55 vacancies adopted in the show Cause Notice.
- c) There are 62 vacancies available for the panel year 1993-94 as against 66 vacancies adopted in the show Cause Notice.
- d) There are 65 vacancies available for the panel year 1995-96 as against 79 vacancies adopted in the show Cause Notice.

e) There are 35 vacancies available for the panel year 1996-97 as against 47 vacancies adopted in the show Cause Notice.

The total number of vacancies arrived at by the Department are highly inflated in as much as certain vacancies have been duplicated and certain others have been adopted without any co-relatable factual basis. It is observed that the Department have no account for 20 vacancies for the period between 1990-91 and 1996-97. The total retirement vacancies against which officiating arrangement as In-Charge CTOs and persons who retired as DCTOs but who are included in the final seniority list of CTOs are 162. 84 new posts were created and 82 CTOs were promoted to the post of Assistant Commissioner during the same period. The total number of vacancies during the period will be only 296 and not 346 (the working of above is mentioned in tabular form i.e for 296 vacancies from 1990 -91 to 1996-97). They requested to consider the said vacancy from position and apportion the same among the DRs and RPs in accordance with the Andhra Pradesh Commercial Taxes Service Rules.

(II) They stated that in the earlier seniority list dt.25.01.2005 48 vacancies were allotted to SCs and 19 vacancies were allotted to STs and this vacancy position become final and was not contested. Against this now in the notice 58 and 21 vacancies were allotted to SCs and STs respectively which is far higher than the earlier figures.

(III) The show cause notice violated the terms of reference in the OA No.702/06 and other OAs by modifying the list beyond these terms. Thus 3 persons were deleted from the list, and in effect elevated rank promotees with long service over his position. Similarly certain persons, who have not completed minimum required service in the cadre of DCTO, have been placed in an advantageous panel year. They have requested to rectify the errors. They have quoted the example of Sri A. Danaiah who figures in the 1978-79 panel year of DCTOs is placed in 1979-80 year panel of CTOs, this has given undue advantage to Rank Promotees with long service and is detrimental to my seniority.

(IV) Sri R. Sanjeev Rao, who figures at Sl.No.631 in the DCTO seniority list does not find place in the present show cause notice. Therefore his name may be incorporated in the seniority list of CTO's.

(V) The representation of Sri I.Srinagesh, AC(CT)(DR C.T.O) and others is to consider to change of their seniority in the panel year 1997-98 basing on the merit ranking given by the APPSC. Further Sri I.Srinagesh has requested to correct his name in the seniority list as Srinagesh Irrinki as spelt in the Gazette No.39, dated.25.09.1997. The name may be corrected.

Reply:

(I) With regard to 50 inflated vacancies, after verification of records and also in consultation with the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes it is found that there are actually 34 inflated vacancies and they were since deleted from the respective panel years(i.e. 1990-91(8), 93-94(6), 95-96(9) and 96-97(11). Apart from this 13 names of officers, who worked and retired as regular CTOs and whose names were missed from the list, were incorporated in the respective panel years(i.e. 1990-91(8), 1992-93(2), 1995-96(2) and 1996-97(1). The

rationale has been explained at point (e) under objections on “General Principles.”

(II) The number of SC/ST vacancies have been calculated strictly following the Rule of Reservation.

(III) The objection that certain persons, who have not completed minimum required service in the cadre of DCTO, have been placed in an advantageous panel year, it is informed that in the show cause notice issued and published in A.P. Gazette No. 137 dt. 31.08.2010 the eligibility criteria for promotion as CTO has been observed. In fact Sri A.Danaiah, who figures in the 1978-79 panel of DCTOs, has been placed in the 1983-84 panel of CTOs.

(IV) Sri. R. Sanjeeva Rao (SC) has not been included but he is eligible to be placed in the seniority list in the panel year. It is found on verification of records that Sri. R. Sanjeeva Rao (SC) retired on 30.11.1995 as DCTO before arising of vacancy (panel year 1995-96). Hence this objection is overruled.

(V) The Hon'ble APAT, in its orders dated.08.06.2011, pronounced the judgment directing that the applicants have made a representation dt.05.03.2011 and further representation, the respondents are directed to consider and pass appropriate orders on the representation of the applicants keeping in view the law governing fixation of seniority inter-se among the direct recruits. Further, the Hon'ble High Court of AP while disposing the WP No.18537/2011 filed by V.Raghunath, AC(CT) and two others and ordered that “ we do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order. However, ends of justice would be met, if the official respondents are directed to consider the objections of the unofficial respondents, uninfluenced by any of the observation made by the Tribunal in the impugned order in the OA. In view of the Hon'ble APAT and High Court orders, the representation of the DR CTOs of 1997 batch is considered basing on Rule 33(b) of the APS & SS Rules, 1996 and the seniority is revised inter-se among the DR CTOs of 1997 batch basing on the merit ranking furnished by the APPSC vide their letter No. 254/RS-29/2010, Dated.21.03.2011. The name of Sri Srinagesh Irrinki has been corrected in the seniority list as requested by the individual.

Objections filed by;
Sri K.V. Ramanaiah, Asst. Commissioner (CT).

The officer has stated that the 1st final seniority list of CTOs was published in 2005, while there was ample scope and space to put Sri K.Raju and him in the vacancies that arose on 16-1-1996 up above the DR CTO who joined in March 1996. As such 13 vacancies were left unutilized willfully and Sri K.Raju and he were assigned a lower notional date of 1-7-1996 which was the date of incharge

arrangement as CTO of Sri K.Raju. The officer has requested to rectify the mistake.

Reply:

His contention that the 13 SC/ST (carry forward) vacancies were left unutilized is not correct since G.O.Ms.No.1086, dated.09.08.2007 was set-a-side by the Hon'ble APAT in OA No.10358/2009, dated.21.06.2010.

Objections filed by:

1. Sri. A.Satyam Babu, Asst. Commissioner (CT).
2. Sri. P.Srinivasa Rao, I/c. Dy.Commissioner (CT).
3. Sri. A.Dayal Das, I/c. Dy.Commissioner (CT).

The above three officers have filed their common objections as follows:

The officers have submitted that their names were not considered up to the panel year 1998-99 though they were appointed on transfer from Secretariat service against vacancies for the panel year 1995-96.

In continuation to their above objections the officers have filed further objections stating that the main contention of the department in revising the seniority is that the quota-rota system in filling-up the posts of CTO's is not correctly arrived at and the SOs/PSs have been appointed in excess of their quota. This is administrative fault of the Revenue Department, O/o. Commissioner (CT). In umpteen number of cases the judicial forums have held that for administrative fault, individuals cannot be penalized. If they were not appointed as CTOs, they would not have come from the Secretariat and their career prospects would have not disturbed and it is very unfair at this length of time to disturb their career prospects.

The officers have filed their further objections stating that the substantive vacancies from 1975-76 to 1993-94 to SOs / PSs arrived at 30 (Thirty). Though the relevant G.O according to which substantive vacancies arrived at by the department is 1:15 was not mentioned by the department. The said calculation was done purportedly based on A.P C.T Service Rules vide G.O.Ms.No.1781 Rev., Dept., dated: 15.10.1963. They have stated that in a cycle of every 10 vacancies the first 9 vacancies shall be filled by promotion of the officers in categories (3) and (4) and the Tenth vacancy shall be filled by transfer from the category of Section Officers of A.P. Secretariat services. When the A.P. Commercial Taxes service rules specify a 10 point cycle for City List candidates right from the date of insertion of the relevant provision, how is that the Department adopted the cycle of 1:15 for the period prior to 1994-95, it was messed up because of non examination of relevant provision and its subsequent amendments' from time to time by the lower staff. The relevant GOs emphasize a 10 point cycle for City List candidates.

They have stated that the dispute for seniority in the cadre of CTOs is between the rank promotees who are officiating in the posts meant for direct recruits. They are neither respondents nor petitioners in O.A.No.702/2006 on which the existing seniority list is proposed to be revised is not relevant to the City List candidates. While they were working as P.S./S.O. in the year 1996 the Government have asked their willingness for appointment as C.T.O.s. They were appointed as CTOs on 06-7-1996.

The contention of the department is that city list candidates were taken in excess of their quota by five for the panel years 1975-76 to 1998-99 and

therefore, the city list candidates were pushed down to subsequent years till vacancies meant for them arise. It seems that City List candidates fall under the category of promotees. But they are not promotees and appointed against substantive vacancies as in the case of direct recruits for want of vacancy reversion of a D.R CTO to a lower post in which they were never appointed is not permissible, similarly the CTO appointed on transfer from Secretariat Service, cannot be reverted as DCTO.

Reply:

The objections filed by the officers have been verified with relevant rules and records available. While finalizing the earlier seniority list published in A.P. Gazette No. 22-A, dt.12-1-2005 the allotment of vacancies were not as per the cycle / rota-quota specified in the A.P.C.T. Service Rules. The present seniority list for the cadre of CTOs has been is prepared on the basis of the directions of the Hon'ble A.P.A.T. in O.A. No. 702/06, dt.29.04.2010. After examining the issue in totality Government have decided to implement the orders of the Hon'ble A.P.A.T, by following the cycle / rota-quota as provided in the service Rules.

The rota-quota principle for allocation of CTO vacancies has been correctly followed as provided in the Special rules. The distribution of vacancies among the 3 feeder categories viz. Direct Recruit, Rank Promotees(DCTO) and City List quota(SOs/PSs) were arrived at in two spells i.e., 15 point cycle for the prior to 23.04.1994 when G.O.Ms.No. 1781 Rev dated 15.10.1963 was in force and 10 point cycle from 23.04.1994, since when G.O.Ms.No. 360 Rev dated 23.4.1994 was adopted. The placement in the respective panels were made appropriately. In order to accommodate the persons as per their slots earmarked for each of the categories, relegation has been made to the lower positions/panels to the persons who could not be accommodated in their own slots. In this exercise, certain city list quota employees have also been relegated to later panels basing availability of vacancies.

Sri P.Srinivasa Rao and Sri A.Dayal Das were seniors to Sri Satyam Babu in the category of CTOs appointed from the City List quota as they were appointed as CTOs in the panel year 1994-95 while Sri A.Satyam Babu was appointed in the 1995-96 panel. Now the names of the first two have been included in the panel years 1996-97 and 1997-98 respectively while Sri A Satyam Babu could not find place up to the panel year 1998-99 due to want of vacancy. His name will be shown at appropriate place in a subsequent panel year. Hence their objection is overruled.

In the reference 14th read above, draft revised panels from the panel year 1975-76 to 1998-99 along with the detailed notes were communicated to the

CCT, Hyderabad and he was requested to place the above panels lists before the review DPC as required under rule 24(a) of A.P.S & S.S Rules, 1996 and send the recommendations of the DPC to Government for finalization of the seniority list in CTO cadre.

In the reference 15th read above, the CCT has furnished the approved CTOs panels from the year 1975-76 to 1998-99 duly placing the matter before the review DPC, as required under rule 24(a) of the APS & SS Rules, 1996. The review DPC after examining the relevant records, has recommended for inclusion of 399 RPs CTOs from the feeder category of DCTOs and 51 CTOs from the city list quota i.e. SOs/PSs in the panel for the year 1975-76 to 1998-99 for promotion as CTOs.

After examination of the recommendations of the review DPC Government have decided to accept the same and accordingly finalize the seniority list of CTOs from the panel years 1975-76 to 1998-99 duly taking into consideration rota-quota rule and communal roster as prescribed in the rules. The names of 553 CTOs are accordingly included in the panel years 1975-76 to 1998-99 against 665 available vacancies leaving 112 vacant slots meant for Direct Recruits. The substantive vacancies meant for DR, RPs and CL Quota is appended as Annexure.I The final seniority list of CTOs from the panel years 1975-76 to 1998-99 is appended as Annexure.II.
