**CCT's Ref.No.D2/146/2011.**- The post of Commercial Tax Officer in the Commercial Taxes Department is a State level post to which the method of recruitment is by 1.Direct recruitment 2. Appointment by transfer from the feeder category of Deputy Commercial Tax Officer and 3. SO/PSs Secretariat quota and the said category was governed by the APCT Service Rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.360, Rev(CT.I) Department dt.23.04.1994, As per the said rules a 10 point cycle of rotation was followed, in which the 10 point cycle was operated as shown below:-

In compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No. 24335/99 and 14538/2000, dated: 9.4.2001 the seniority list of Deputy Commercial Tax Officers was finalized and published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette No.331, dated 20.8.2004. Consequent on the finalization of the seniority list of Deputy Commercial Tax Officers, the provisional seniority list of Commercial Tax Officers was prepared from 18.10.1975 to 31.8.1999 and after considering the objections received, the seniority list was finalized for the period from 1975-76 to 1998-99 and published in A.P. Gazette No. 22-A Dt.12-1-2005.

Certain Direct recruit CTOs filed an O.A. No. 702 /2006 against the final seniority list of CTO finalized and published in A.P. Gazette No. 22-A, dt. 12-01-2005.

It is further informed that the O.A. No. 702/2006 along with the M.A. No. 1307/2008 filed by the applicants came up for hearing before the Hon'ble Tribunal on 20.06.2008 and after consideration of the counter affidavit filed by the official respondents, the Hon'ble Tribunal dismissed the O.A. along with the M.A. Aggrieved by the above orders of the Hon'ble A.P.A.T. the applicants filed W.P. NO.13556 of 2008 along with the W.P.M.P. No. 17496 of 2008 before the Hon'ble High Court. The Hon'ble Court in its interim orders, dt. 27.06.2008 directed the Government not to effect the promotions in the cadre of Deputy Commissioners, The Hon'ble High Court in its final order dt. 08.07.2008 in this W.P., remitted the case back to the Hon'ble Tribunal, with a direction to dispose the same afresh on merits and as per law *duly adjudicating upon the final seniority list* within a period of four weeks from the date of the order and till such time the interim orders passed by the Hon'ble Court on 27.06.2008 not to affect the promotions to the cadre of Deputy Commissioner, shall continue.

Some of the officers approach Supreme Court against the orders of High Court. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its interim orders dt.11.09.2008 in SLP (Civil) No. 21867/2008 filed by Sri B. Surya Prakash and others

inst the orders of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No. 13556/2008, ordered status-quo regarding promotions to be maintained until further orders.

As per direction of Hon'ble High Court in its final orders dt. 29.04.2010 in OA No. 702/06 has allowed the respondents and directed the respondents to approve the revised seniority of CTOs. Accordingly, Government directed the Commissioner (CT) to issue show cause notice to revise the seniority list and send proposal to Government. Accordingly a show cause notice to revise the said seniority list was issued and published in the A.P. Gazette No. 100, dt. 31.08.2010. The Government have finalized Seniority list of CTOs for the Panel year from 1975-76 to 1988-89 vide G.O.Ms.No.1661 Rev (CT.I) Department, dated: 25.08.2011.

The Government have issued instructions vide Govt. Memo.No.17484/CT.I (1)/2011, dated: 07.05.2011 to prepare seniority list of Commercial Tax Officers for the Panel Year 1999-2000 onwards, duly taking into account objections raised to the existing adhoc lists and the spill-over list of CTOs who could not find place in the seniority list prepared by the Government from 1975-76 to 1998-99, and then submit the same to the Government for consideration.

1. 10 point cycle of rotation was followed as per G.O.Ms.No.360 dt.23.4.1994.
2. Communal roster for SC/ST reservation was followed adopting 100 point cycle.
3. Interse seniority amongst direct recruit CTOs was followed as per the list furnished by APPSC.
4. City list candidates were placed in the seniority list as per the dates of their joining.

The above individuals have filed common objections that they have asked the date of joining in the post, date of promotion, date of declaration of probation, date of arising of the in which the individual is placed date of regularization are not available in the seniority list the individuals have stated that in the absence of the above details can not file the objections. They have requested to provide the copies of the references 1 to 13 of Show Cause Notice, dated: 05.11.2011.

2. Further, they submit that the principle of Rota quota was followed in the case of Direct Recruit CTO while finalization of seniority list upto 1998-99 by the Government and for the subsequent period 1999-2000 to 2008-09. But in case of Direct Recruit of ACTOs the same analogy has not been followed in spite of directions from the Hon'ble A.P.A.T in subsequent instructions by the Government.

3. That they were promoted as CTO after conducting DPC against regular vacancy meant for promotees and it was not mentioned anywhere in the promotion order that they were promoted against D.R. vacancy. They have requested to provide the basic information to file objections and extended the time limit for the one month after providing the information for filing their objections.

### Replies to Objections:

In reply to para 1 that the objections regarding the date of regularization and declaration of probation and date of arising of vacancy do not arise, because they were promoted temporarily under rule 10 (a) of A.P.S. & S.S. Rules, 1996 on adhoc basis. With regard to provide the copies of the references 1 to 13 of Show Cause Notice, dated: 05.11.2011, there were asked vide CCT's Ref. No. D2/D2/1501/2007, dated: 14.12.2011 to pay certain amount for the cost of the papers around Rs. 650/-.

In reply to para 2 above, the objections are pertaining to the seniority list of ACTOs and not related to this show cause notice which is related to the seniority list of CTOs. Hence, the objection is not tenable and therefore it is over ruled.

In reply to the para 3 above the individuals who are mentioned above are promoted temporarily as CTOs on adhoc basis and mentioned in the proceedings that the promotion is under 10(a) of A.P.S & S.S Rules, 1996. Hence, the objection is over ruled.

1. The above individuals filed common objections stating that some of the Section Officers of the A.P. Secretariat were appointed as CTOs by transfer. They were joined subsequently to their parent Department viz Secretariat without continuing in the C.T. Department. But their names are figuring in the proposal seniority list (9 Names are mentioned).

2. As per the final seniority list of CTOs from 1975-76 to 1998-99 it is noticed that twenty (20) names were included in different panel years but they actually retired from service before the panel year in which their names were included. Due to erroneous inclusion of the said twenty (20) names in the seniority list, the last twenty (20) names of the individuals who were included in the earlier panel were relegated to subsequent panel years i.e., 1999-2000 to 2004-05 which has adversely affected their seniority in the cadre of CTO.

3. They submit that while finalizing seniority list from 1975-76 to 1998-99 the Government have removed (34) posts for the years 1991-93 to 1996-97. These posts are incharge promotions of CTOs, but actually the Incharge promotions of CTOs their salaries were drawn in the posts of CTOs and further the resultant vacancies of DCTOs and ACTOs were given. Hence, the removal of (34) posts from the cadre strength is correct.

4. That the following names of the CTO are erroneously included in the list even though they do not qualified for inclusion of their names in the seniority list due the reasons mentioned there in.

#### Replies to Objections:

1. It is informed that the individuals mentioned in the objections were appointed by transfer as CTOs in the vacancies earmarked for city list. All the SOs appointed as CTOs through DPC were reported to duty and worked as CTOs. Since they have availed the vacancies meant for city list quota, they have joined in the Department and worked as CTOs. The objections that they cannot be included in the Seniority list is not tenable and hence overruled.

2 & 3. In reply to para 2 & 3 above, the objections are pertaining to the seniority list of CTOs from 1975-76 to 1998-99 which is already finalized by the Government Vide G.O.Ms.No.1661, dated: 25.08.2011 and not related to this Show Cause Notice which is related to the seniority list of CTOs from 1999-2000 to 2008-2009. Hence, the objection is not tenable and therefore it is over ruled.

4 As verified from the records: Kum. V.K.S.N.A. Padma, expired on 23.02.1997, Sri K.S. Bapi Raju, expired on 19.02.2001, Sri M. Ramalingam, expired on 11.01.2002, Sri D. Rajendra Prasad, expired on 20.11.1992, Sri P. Satyanarayana Rao, expired on 31.07.1999, Sri Y. Sudhakara Rao, Voluntary retirement on 30.04.2004, Sri M.V. Chakradhara Rao, expired on 18.02.2002, Sri G. Ayyanna, expired on 06.12.2001, Sri S. Gangulu, expired on 29.03.2000, Sri V. Surya Prakasam, expired on 01.06.1995, Sri B.V. Narayana Kumar, dismissed vide G.O.Ms.No.862 Rev (Vig.I) Department, dated: 6.8.2003, Sri Basher Baig, deferred in the adhoc panels of CTOs for the year 2004-05 due to punishment pending the DPC held on 12.01.2005, Sri G. Rama Murthy, deferred in adhoc panel of CTOs 2004-05 since the individual has not passed E.O test. Sri M. Rahamatulla, deferred in adhoc panel of CTOs 2004-05 due to charges pending thereafter punishment imposed. Hence, the above said 14 names is deleted from panel of CTOs proposed in Show Cause Notice. With regard to Sri S. Ramachandarachari and Smt. D.D.A. Jayamani there are no charges, pending and they were in service while their names included in the respective panels. Hence, the objections are overruled for including of the said two officers.

**Objections filed by M. Satyaprakash, CTO, Ongole-II Circle:**

The officer has filed objection stating that he was recruited to Group-I Services as CTO by APPSC during the year 2007. He has joined duty on 01.03.2007. His name is placed at Sl.No.3 as per the selection list communicated by the APPSC. On perusal of show cause notice his name is not included in the list and there are no reason assigned to it. The names of entire batch mates are included in the list. Further, he has stated that his probation is still pending and kept in abeyance as certain clarification sought in the case from the Government. The individual has requested to obtain the clarification and declare the probation and then finalize the seniority of CTOs.

**Replies to Objections:**

The objection of the officer is examined and further the Government have issued G.O.Rt.No.1495 Rev (CT.I), Department, dated: 17.12.2011, relaxing Rule 16 (h) in his favour. Hence, his name is included now in the seniority list as per his ranking given by APPSC, Hyderabad.

**Objection filed by Smt. G. Sumathi, CTO, Vengal Rao Nagar Circle:**

- (i) The officer has filed objection stating that (i). As per Rule 33 (b) of A.P.S & SS Rules, 1996 the list communicated initially by the APPSC in order of reservation was also in consonance with Rules and Rule of reservation specified in the constitution and established law. The order of preference assigned by the APPSC or any selecting authority shall not be disturbed inter-se while determining the seniority.
- (ii) Modifying the dates of regularization and declaration of probation, there is no case of precedence to her batch. The seniority is disturbed to implement the judgment given in a specific case in which she is not a respondent to be binding the Hon'ble A.P.A.T issued "Status quo" orders in W.P.No. 18740 and 18773, dated: 28.04.2011.
- (iii) Seniority of a person in the service will come into operation only on his joining duty in service on such appointment the Rule 3(vi) and (vii) of APPSC Rule can not override Rule 22(e) of A.P.S & SS Rules, 1996.
- (iv) The roster fitment communicated by the APPSC she was placed in 6<sup>th</sup> Position. But the proposal list based on merit gets down to the 11<sup>th</sup> position, which is not in violation to any rules or Constitution provisions may not the withdraw for prospective implementation of Hon'ble A.P.A.T Judgment. Implementation of the same was stayed the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. She has requested to Act in interest of justice and rule of reservation as specified in constitution and APS & SS Rules, 1996.

**Replies to Objections:**

- (i) In reply to para 1 seniority of Direct Recruits is placed under Rule 33 (b) APS & SS Rules, 1996 as per the Merit List furnished by the APPSC Vide Lr.No.1430/RS-29/2003, dated: 28.01.2011 and without influenced by the cases mentioned in the objections.
- (ii) The objection para 2 is not relating to this Show Cause Notice of seniority list of CTOs hence, it is over ruled.
- (iii) Seniority of the individual is placed Rule 33 (b). APS & SS Rules, 1996 as per the Merit List furnished by the APPSC Vide Lr.No.1430/RS-29/2003, dated: 28.01.2011.

(In reply to para IV the seniority of individual is placed, under Rule 33 (b) APS & SS Rules, 1996 as per the Merit List furnished by the APPSC Vide Lr.No.1430/RS-29/2003, dated: 28.01.2011 and without influenced by the cases mentioned in the objections.

**Objections filed by Sri B. Papa Rao, CTO, O/o.CCT, Hyderabad:**

The officer has filed his objection stating that his name is placed below the Direct Recruit CTOs of 2006-07 batch. As per roster points his name has to be placed above the D.R CTOs, hence requested to put his name above DR CTOs.

Further, the officer has stated that the following CTOs were expired who are shown in the Show Cause Notice at Sl.No.06. Smt. Padma, Sl.No.25 Sri E. Sambasiva Rao,(city-list) Sl.No.28 Sri M. Ramalingam, Sl.No.44. M.Chakradhar Rao, Sl.No.47. Sri G. Ayyanna. He has requested to change the Roster Points in the above vacancies and put his name at Sl.No.155 in the list.

**Replies to Objections:**

As verified the records in this office, Smt.V.K.S.N.A. Padma expired on 23.02.1997, Sri M. Ramalingam expired on 11.01.2002, Sri M.V. Chakradhar Rao expired on 18.02.2002, Sri G. Ayyanna expired on 06.12.2001, i.e., they were expired before their names included in the respective Panel years hence the said names are now deleted in the seniority list. Sri E. Samabasiva Rao expired after join as CTO in this Department under city list quota. Hence the objection in respect of E. Sambasiva Rao is overruled.

**Objections filed by Sri K. Bala Sundaram, CTO (Retired):**

The Retired Officer submitted that Sri M. Ramalingam Sl.No.28 belongs to SC was expired long back when he was as DCTO in Warangal division. Sri P. Rama Rao Sl.No.35 was wrongly shown at Roster No.97 as he belongs to City List Quota, Sri K. Mahender Rao at Sl.No.41 and Sri T. Ramanaiah Sl.No.58 are rank promotees clerical cadre. As DR ACTO is position should be above the two (2) officers. Sri G. Ayyanna expired in the year 2001 hence, keeping the name in the panel year 2003-04 is not correct. The officer has requested to fix his seniority Sl.No.28 and communal roster point Sl.No.91.

**Replies to Objections:**

As verified from the records available in this office, Sri M. Ramalingam expired on 11.01.2002, Sri G. Ayyanna expired on 06.12.2001 i.e., they were expired before their names included in the respective Panel years hence the said names are now deleted in the seniority list. Sri P. Rama Rao relating to City List Quota in DCTOs post but not in CTOs list. Sri K. Mahender Rao and Sri P. Ramanaiah are Rank Promotees in ACTO cadre. These names are placed in the CTO panels as per DCTOs seniority list but not ACTOs seniority list. They were seniors i.e., Sl.No.772 & 823 in the seniority list of DCTOs Sri Balasundaram is at Sl.No.847. Hence, the objections in respect of Sri P. Rama Rao, Sri K. Mahender Rao and Sri T. Ramanaiah are overruled.

**Objections filed by Sri M. Vijaya Rao, CTO, Tuni Circle:**

The officer has filed his objection stating the he belongs to SC Community. His name was not considered against SC Point, which resulted so many places below than his batch mates like G. Robert Wilson and M. Subramanyam, in ACTO cadre. How his name is fixed at Sl.No.236 in the panel year 2008-09 the officer has requested to take into consideration of his community SC Roster point and incorporate his name along with his batch mates.

**Replies to Objections:**

As verified from the available records in this office, Sri M. Vijaya Rao belongs to SC community. Hence, he is placed at Communal Roster No.41 earmarked to SC in the panel year 2007-2008. His objection is allowed.

**Objections filed by Smt D. Subhadramma AC (CT) (Audit):**

The officer has filed her objections stating that she has joined as I/c. CTO, dated: 26.09.1996 further she was appointed as CTO on adhoc basis w.e.f 22.11.1997. In CCT's Ref.No.D2/1990/2004, dated: 07.10.2004 a Show Cause Notice was issued and her name was proposed at Sl.No.626 for the Panel Year 1997-98 in the cadre of CTO



later the Show Cause Notice was finalized. Further, in CCT's Ref.No.D2/854/2005, dated: 29.07.2010 Show Cause Notice issued and finalized up to the Panel Year 1998-99 her name was not figured. In the Show Cause Notice dated: 05.11.2011 her name was figured at Sl.No.57 against Communal Roster Point No.15 in the Panel Year 2004-05. Therefore, she has requested to take up the issue a fresh by taking into to the consideration of a Cycle of every hundred vacancies for which the direct recruitment as well as the city list candidates are considered.

If the substantive vacancies only taken into consideration, a cycle of 100 substantive vacancies are to be taken into consideration for the purpose of finalization of the seniority list of CTOs and all the cases of directed recruits, city list and rank promotees are to be taken into consideration as per their respective quota. The dates of joining of city list candidate and direct recruits are not mention in the show cause notice. Their date of joining is also an important aspect for the purpose of seniority.

The individual has submitted that, after completion of 14 years regular service of CTO, her name was proposed to relegated from 1997-98 to 2004-05 in the Show Cause Notice; after the candidates who have joined after her date of regularization of CTO on 22.11.1997. Therefore, she has requested to place her name in a vacancy arose in the panel year 1997-98 instead of 2004-05.

#### Replies to Objections:

In reply to the objection the seniority list is prepared basing on the regular panels prepared as per A.P.C.T Service Rules, 1994 under Rule 3 duly followed the note (1) i.e., 10 point cycle accordingly her name is placed in the panel year 2004-05. The individual is mentioned that she has completed 14 years of regular service of CTO is not correct. She has promoted temporarily as CTO under Rule 10 (a) of APS & SS-Rules, 1994 and joined on 22.11.1997 on adhoc basis. As per regular panels her name is placed in 2004-05. Hence, her objection is over ruled.

#### Objections filed by Sri T. Lakshmi Narayana .CTO (Retired):

The retired officer has filed his objections stating that he was promoted as CTO w.e.f 08.06.2006 and have been worked upto 30.06.2011 and retired on attaining the age of superannuation his name should have been shown in the panel year 2005-06, but his name did not placed any where in the proposed list upto the Panel Year 2008-09.

The individual has submitted that he is not able to elicit any valid reasons for non-inclusion of his name in the provisional list prepared and communicated. He has submitted that the Apex Court of India has repeatedly exhorted that the Rota-Quota is only for earmarking vacancies for different sources of recruitment provided under the Special Rules and when once the individuals are appointed to service in accordance with the rules, the seniority should be determined with reference to the date of joining of such individuals. f (1). Principles / Parameters observed in preparation of the Provisional list (2). Date of joining of the individuals included in the present provisional list and others those who were actually appointed up to 2009 but not included in the list. (3) Source of vacancies in each panel year and the calculation of substantive and temporary vacancies in each year. (4) Copies of the DPC Proceedings on each occasion of promotions effected during the years 2004 to 2009. (5) Calculation made and Vacancies notified to the APPSC for Direct Recruitment, allotment made by the Service Commissioner against such notifications from time to time during the years 2004 to 2009 including backlog if any at the beginning with basis for the same. (6). Copies of the Government instructions and Judgments cited and followed in preparation of the provisional list communicated.

#### Replies to Objections:

The retired officer promoted as CTO on adhoc basis under Rule 10 (a) of APS & SS Rules, 1996 and joined as CTO 08.06.2006 as per regular panels prepared under A.P.C.T Service Rules, 1994 his name cannot find place to 2008-09. No junior to him has find place till 2008-09. The seniority list of CTOs is now prepared strictly as per the directions of Hon'ble A.P.A.T dated: 29.04.2010 in O.A.No.702 of 2006 and also as per the instructions of the Government Vide Memo.7484/CT.I(1)/2011, dated: 07.05.2011.

The individual has requested to provide certain information mentioned in his objection for the above 6 items. The retired officer was informed to come and peruse the records in the office of Commissioner (CT), Hyderabad on or before 12.01.2012. The officer has perused the records on 09.01.2012. After perusal of records he has not filed any objection.

The matter has been placed before the Review DPC for approval of CTOs panel from the year 1999-2000 to 2007-08 has required under rule 24(a) of APS & SS Rules, 1996. The review DPC after examining the relevant records, has recommended for inclusion of 171 RPs CTOs from the feeder category of DCTOs and 17 CTOs for the city list quota i.e., SOs/PSs in the panel for the year 1999-2000 to 2007-08 for promotion as CTOs.

After examination of the recommendations of the review DPC it is decided to accept the same and accordingly finalise the seniority list of CTOs from the panel years 1999-2000 to 2007-08 duly taking in to consideration quota-quota rule and communal roster as prescribed in the rules. The names of 222 CTOs are accordingly included in the panel years 1999-2000 to 2007-08 against 286 available vacancies leaving 64 vacant slots meant for direct recruits and 12 vacant slots meant for city list. The substantive vacancies meant for DRs, RPs and CLs quota is appended as Annexure-I. The final seniority list of CTOs from the panel years 1999-2000 to 2007-08 is appended as Annexure-II.
